PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

THIRTY-NINTH ANNUAL REPORT OF FAROOK COLLEGE 1986—'87

PRESENTED BY PRINCIPAL PROF.U. MOHAMMED AT THE COLLEGE DAY ON 3RD MARCH, 1987.

I take pleasure in presenting before you the 39th Annual Report of Farook College in the presence of our esteemed guest Janab A. K. Kaderkutty Sahib, an industrialist of national repute and a well-known patron of many educational and cultural organizations in the State, who has been closely associated with our College in various capacities. Here are the salient features of the activities of Farook College during 1986-87.

COURSES & PERFORMANCE :

The College reopened on 2 June 1986: The total strength for the year was 2419 including 852 girls, and 5 students from abroad. LIBRARY :

The College Library has at present a collection of 50,950 books. 1640 books were added this year. The library subscribes to 191 periodicals of which 94 are bound and preserved. The bound periodical section has a collection of 1326 volumes. There is a separate collection of Audio-visual aids including television, sound projector, slides, films, film strips, cassettes, etc. This year the library utilized more than Rs. 1.3 lakhs. On the Commemoration Day of Indira Gandhi, the Library conducted an exhibition titled 'Priyadarshini'. the exhibits included photos, paper cuttings, books and published materials on the assassination of our late Prime Minister. The Library prepared and distributed a booklet on the effective use of the Library. There is a Career Guidance Bureau attached to the Library. Arrangements have been made to show telecasts of U. G. C. Programmes on higher education over the national network.

SCHOLARSHIPS :

An many as 1,180 students are getting various scholarships and concessions. These include National Loan Scholarship, National and University Merit Scholarships, Scholarship for the blind and for the Physically handicapped, and scholarships from Poor Boys Fund and Students Aid Fund of the College.

'U. 6. C. BRANTS

A major source of help and encouragement has been the University Grants Commission. The following grants were sanctioned during the VI Plan period:~

Basic Assistance - Rs. 1,75,000/-, Degree Development Grant-Rs. 2,48,400/- and P. C. Development Grant-Rs. 7,00.000/-.

An amount of Rs. 2.80.000/~ has been approved by the Commission as Basic Assistance for the Seventh Plan Period ending 31~3~1990. This year we received Rs. 1,50,000/~. These grants are being utilized by the College mainly for purchase of books and equipment, for the deputation of teachers under the Faculty Improvement Programme, and for the construction of buildings under approved schemes. The College is looking forward to the continued assistance from the UGC for its various development programmes during the 7th Five Year Plan.

As in previous years, special coaching classes were held to help weak students. A Quiz Club and a Debating Club have been formed to develop the latent talents in students.

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:

MAPPILA STUDIES-DUM-RESEARCH DENTRE. The MSRC has been collecting materials relating to Mappila history and culture. These are of immense value to researchers and it is hoped that they would grow with continued patronage and co-operation of our well-wishers. The MSRC is also compiling data on contemporary events.

ADULT EDU ATION PROGRAMME: The ten adult education centres sanctioned by the University under point 16 of the 20 point programme functioned up to September. The centres had to be suspended owing to non-receipt funds from the University.

PARENT-TEAGHER ASSOCIATION: The general body of the P. T. A. met once, and the executive committee met twice during the year. The Association provided funds for the completion of the Open Air Theatre. It also awarded cash prizes to students who secured first and second places in the Half Yearly Examination in each group of Pre-Degree course.

DLD STUDENT ASSOCIATION: The Fourth Abussabah Memorial Extension Lecture wes delivered by Sri. Nitya Chaitanya Yati. At a well attended function he spoke on the topic of 'Mysticism in Islam'.

INDIA PUPULATION PROJECT III: Classes were held on various aspects of population and family welfare, under the joint auspices of NSS and Adult Education units of the College. The classes were given by personnel of the District Health Office and staff of Economics and Commerce Departments of this college. Film Shows on health, hygiene and population were also arranged with the help of the Health Department.

CAMPUS ROUNDUP

The stage of Open Air Theatre is being constructed with the active assistance of the Managing Committee, the P. T. A. and the students union. Extension of the Library and enhancement of facilities for women and for sports are being taken up shortly.

HEALTH GENTRE: The Jubilee Health Centre has a Medical Officer and para-medical staff. The Health Centre has been functioning without any improvement. Assistances has been sought from the Central Government for augmenting facilities.

There are twenty quarters provide accommodation for staff. Construction of quarteres for the non-teaching staff is under consideration.

The Canteen is being run by a licensee. Scarcity of water still continues, although the situation has eased with the digging of tube wells.

CONCLUSION

Looking back on the activities on the campus during the past year, one is gratified that, barring a few interruptions caused by extraneous circumstances such as the Pre-Degree Board agitation, the P. G. Syllabus agitation etc. it has been a year of peace and steady work. Co-operation came in ample measure from the Management, the parents, the teaching and non-teaching community and the students. The very generous offer of help promised by the Management; the Parent-Teacher Association and the student's union this year, and the steady support of the Management that I could always rely on, give me confidence that the developmental projects taken up can be successfully completed; that we can meet the educational and cultural needs of the academic community to the full satisfaction of the community that is looking up to this campus with great expectations.
