Activities of Various Departments

The department won championship of the year in the commet 2007 organized by EMEA College. A two day workshop was organized for the students on enterpreneurship department.

The dept of History held a series of extension lecturers in the college during the current year. Three seminars and four workshops at the National Level orgonized by the History Dept.

The dept. of Economics conducted an essay competition on sustainable development of Kerala', problems and prospects on November 30, 2006. The Hon'ble Mayor

Mr. M Bhaskaran delivered the inaugural talk on sustainable development and the role of local self govts. The department organized a Film show on September 11th, Myth and Reality on June 27 and a seminar on career opportunities in Economics.

Physical Education Department went to glorious hights in the various disciplines getting selected to many teams of the Calicut University. It is bringing many laurels and Trophies to the College. Consecutively for the 8th year the shuttle badminton team, the soft bal team retained the University Inter Zone Trophy for the 2nd year succession in Calicut District Large Championship for the 4th year in succession and also represented Kerala in the Senior Nationals. The Cricket Team is the runner-up in the Inter zone Championship. They also won the Calicut District. Division League Championship. The College Tennis team became the runner-up of the Calicut University Inter Zone Championship. The foot ball team retained the A Zone championship for the 2nd team also. The College Volly ball team was the Runners up in the A Zone tournament and was the Semi Finalst in Inter zone tournament.

In the dept. of mass Communication and Journalism, first Semester MCJ classes started on August 28, 2006. A talk was arranged on Law and the Media. Opportunities were created for interaction with Media people from BBC, Kairali and Asianet News TV.

INFORMATIC CENTRE

The informatic centre of the college conducted free training in Internet usage for teachers and for UG and PG students and demonstration class to teachers in each dept on how to explore Campus Network. Seminars were conduted on personality development and monitor assembly and components and identifications Centre signed an Mou with BMG academy start Multimedia course.

THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

Conducted an exhibition of books and posters and number of books were talks held under the Reader's forum. The College Library held a workshop on Best practices in college libraries for the college Principals and librarians under Calicut and Kannur Universities. The college library extended consultancy service to a few of the public libraries. The Library extend its working time up to p.m evening. A two days oriental programme was conducted on 10/04/2007 to the libraries of CBSC schools.

PTA

Eight members were elected as exicutive members. four members were elected as members of the advisory committé. The PTA is doing everything to remove difficulties fa ced by the students.

HEALTH CENTRE

A pain and Paliative Clinic functions at the college to provide Medicines to the patients with terminal diagnosis. The patients in Ramanattukara. Vazhayoor and Feroke Panchayath are benefitted by the scheme.

THE FILS

The FILS conducted various language proficiency course for the Private and Regular students during this academic year. A special course was provided to the teachers of Calicut Islamic Higher Secondary School to enhance teaching skill. Job aspirants were given special coaching in writting competitive exams and Language Quiz under the auspices of the FILS.

PM INSTITUTE OF CIVIL SERVICE EXAM

An entrance test and a personality test were held. A coaching programme for college students was inaugurated by Mr. P.M.A Hakeem former Secretary of India on November 11, 2006. RCC

The remedial Coaching centre gives classes for English, Statistics, Chemistry and Mathematics in addition to University Exam oriented classes.

FAEA

Under the auspices of the FAEA the special classes were arranged for Civil Service examination in General English, Modern Indian History, Indian Economy, Geography, etc. Two days workshop was organized by FAEA on 'Learning to Learn'.

NSS

There were 4 one day Camp and a 10 day special camp. The NSS units are constructing two houses. One in Chullipparambu in Ramanattukara Panchayath and another Feroke Panchayath.

HOSTELS

There are 4 boys and 4 girls hostels housing 237 boys and 600 girls.

EDU SUPPORT
