The college has retained its invincible status of winning hattrick at the University level by being the champion in the Interzone festival conducted at Govt. College, Pattambi. Sri. Midhun Das of III BBA has been selected Kala Prathiba at the interzone festival for the 3rd time in succession. Our college has made ground-breaking achievements by scoring a century and becoming the champion in both the stage and off-stage events. Sri. Abdulla kutty of MCJ bagged the Sarga Prathiba title.

The year is vibrant with activities of academic and non-academic kinds. Under the auspices of the departments of the college several extension lectures, workshops and discussions and UGC sponsored seminar have been organized by the departments of the college.

The annual meeting of the FOSA celebrated on August 10, 2008 was one of the memorable experiences. On the occasion awards were distributed to the rank holders. A sense of nostalgia and feeling of solidarity pervaded the campus and the college which became the venue of various generations of people. Distinguished personalities attended the meet.

The college is continuing its saga of victory in the field of sports too. The college Shuttle Badminton Team retained the University trophy successively for the 10th time. Handball Softball and Baseball teams also made superb performance beginning the university championship. A grant of Rs. 35/- lakh under BSR/CPE was utilized by all science departments for the renovation of the science laboratories. Another Rs. 42/- lakh is sanctioned by the UGC this year for the same purpose.

HEALTH CENTRE

Jubilee health centre provides free medical aid to the students & the local public. The centre organized an awareness class on HIV/AIDS and conducted 4 classes on “ Adolescent Health problems of Girls”

REMEDIAL COACHING CENTRE

The centre conducts remedial classes in English, Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Business Statistics, Management, Accounting & QT. This year students from minority community also are given admission.

P.M INSTITUTE OF CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION

Eleven students qualified the civil service preliminary exam held in May 2008 and four of the them cleared the final and preparing for the interview. Twenty Five civil service aspirants are admitted under regular on campus stream while 13 candidates are admitted to the off campus steam. 20 UG students form Farook College other campuses are undergoing foundation course in civil service.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

A well organized digital library has been set up with the support of Mr.Abdul Wahab M.P, under his MPLAD scheme. Two exhiblition related Mahatma Gandhi & Republic of Indian attracted huge crowd.
