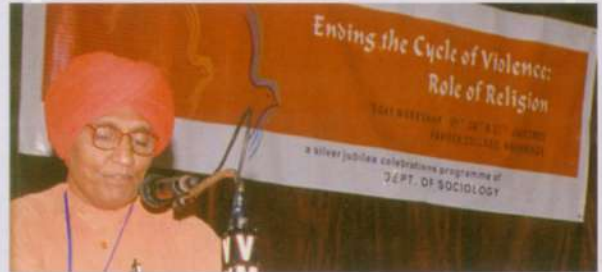

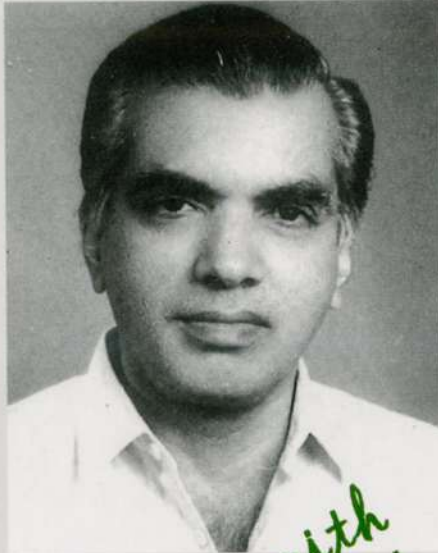

K.C. Hassankutty Saheb is no more. A life-time service to the campus institutions came to an end on 09.05.2006 upon his death.

When one thinks of *KC*- as people affectionately loved to call him- you don't know, where to begin and where to end. So varied and wide-spread were his activities that you could not reduce them to a common denominator. The official positions he occupied in the campus and outside were numerous. The organisations that were keen to entrust him any responsibility had only one practical thought before them: "If you want to get anything done give it to the busiest man." And sure enough *KC* never failed them upto the very end of his life.

In the campus, he was familiar to every institution, old and the new. No committee ever took shape without him. He served all of them with great distinction- as president, secretary or treasurer. Before assuming the presidentship of the Farook College Managing Committee, he had a long spell as its secretary. It was during this period that the college won many laurels. Accreditation of the college at five star level by NAAC, identification of the college by the U.G.C. as a college with potential for excellence, Moulana Abul Kalam Literacy Award were some of the distinctions won by the college through the excellent team work under his patronage and guidance. He was an excellent captain and efficient organiser.

It will not be fair to confine *KC*'s contributions to the field of education alone. They spread over to the areas of sports and games, social service, business and commerce alike. Whatever field he touched, he left his stamp and authority over it. *KC* may have left us physically but his great services to the community will always be remembered with respect. Great soldiers, they say, never die they only fade away!

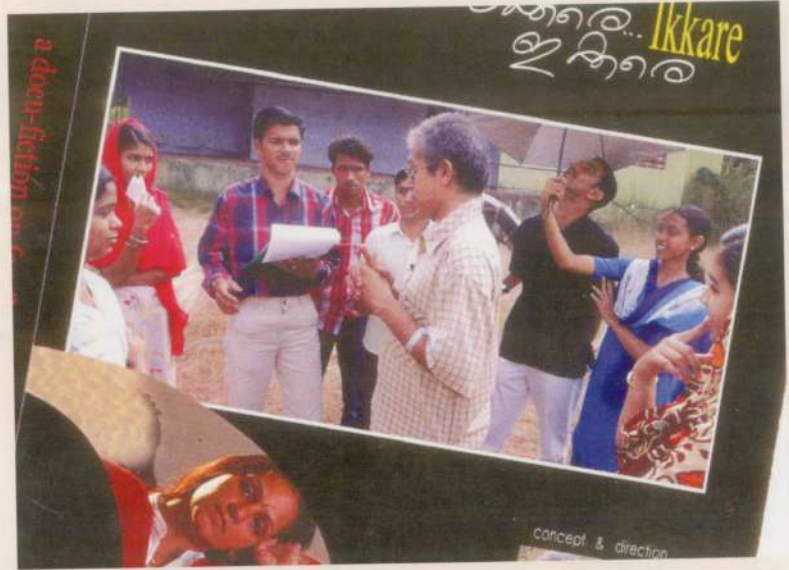
