

BOTANY

In an era of rising interest in health and medicinal plants, the Department of Botany rose to the challenge and conducted a UGC sponsored minor research project on the Medicinal Plants of the locality with special emphasis on their application in treatment of skin diseases, arthritis, heart diseases, pulmonary diseases, hepatitis, neuro disorders etc. The Plants collected by the students were subjected to the detailed study of Morphology, Taxonomy, Chemical properties and applications in treatment. Mr. R.V. Ibrahim is the principal investigator of the project. A Herbal Garden and Herbarium was set up in the Department and it was made available to the public for identification of medicinal plants and sample collections.

Botany Students Association was inaugurated by Dr. M. Sabu, Reader, Dept of Botany, University of Calicut in December 2006 with a talk on Ornamental and Medicinal Gingers, accompanied by a slide show.


