In Search of Extra Terrestrial Planets

On 02 December 2015, Prof. K. Papputty, former Physics teacher and an astronomy enthusiast made an extension lecture on "Man's enthusiasm in the search of extra terrestrial planets and its relevance". Prof. Papputty explained the birth of a star, its evolution and the methods to find stars. He has also described in detail the interference method, Gravitational Lensing, Qusars, Microlensing method, and Transit method.

The workshop on "Introduction to LaTeX" was held at the Statistical Computing lab on 06 March 2015. The programme was of immense help to students to prepare tex documentation, journal papers and project report writing.

Dr. P.T. Ajithkumar, Holography scientist delivered a talk on "Sculpting light". He has explained how laser light is utilized to form holograms which are widely used for institutional and industrial needs. He explained different types of holograms such as transmission and reflection holograms.

Energy conservation using eco-friendly LED Lamps

The year 2015 has been declared as the **International Year of Light and Light-based Technologies (IYL 2015)** that aims to raise awareness of the achievements of light science and its applications, and its importance to humankind. The Department of Physics has organized an awareness programme on "Conservation of Light Energy" and a workshop on "Assembling of LED Lamps".

As the first stage of the programme, LED awareness classes were given to B.Sc. (Physics) students on energy consumption on 14 February 2015. These students visited 62 houses in the nearby village Azhinjilam on 19 and 21 February and conducted a survey on the type of light sources they are using. Survey showed that most of the people were using either incandescent bulbs or fluorescent lamps. They are not familiar with the energy profit and cost saving potential of using LED light bulbs. The students made them aware of the advantages of LEDs and their energy conservation mechanism, which attracted the local people and there were further enquiries from them about the availability of LED bulbs.

On 21 March 2015, B.Sc. (Physics) students were given hands on training to assemble LED lamps with readily available lamp parts in open market. During the one day programme, the first session was a talk by M.P.C. Nambiar on energy conservation followed by a practical session on LED lamp assembling. During the second session students were given components of LED bulbs and M.P.C. Nambiar demonstrated how to assemble the LED lamps. The students have fabricated 15 numbers of LED bulbs and all of these were used in the B.Sc (Physics) lab, replacing the old incandescent bulbs. The next phase of the programme will propagate the message of LED fabrication to the Azhinjilam village by using the trained students.

A two day Seminar on the topic "Light, Energy and Environment" was conducted at the Department of Physics, Farook College, Kozhikode during 27-28, March 2015.

Farook College Publications Division released the following five books during 2014-15 of which the first four books are written by our students.






E.T. Mohamed Basheer, M. P. releases the book on Moulana Abussabah Ahamed Ali
