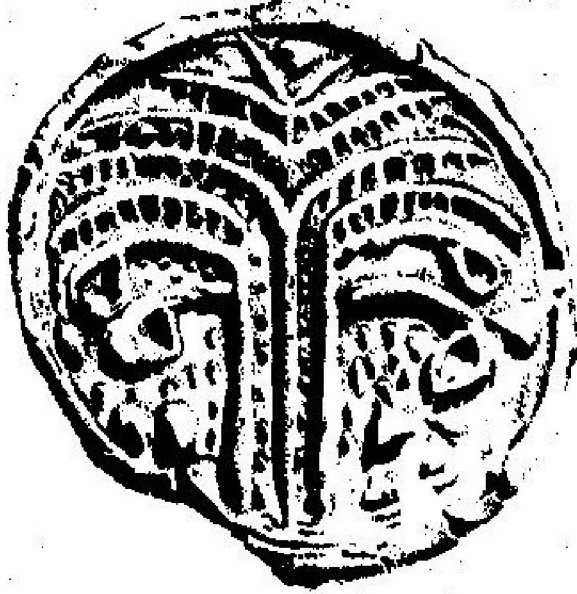

The college emblem presents a simple design consisting of three harmoniously arranged sectors with a co-ordinating crescent-and-star at the centre, and a motto inscribed underneath. The balance in the top sector symbolises justice, equality before law, harmony of design and proportion, and the condition of being steady. The open book in the second sector signifies dissemination of knowledge and its accessibility to all. The coconut palms and the sea in the third sector represent Kerala and the Arabian Sea, whose histories have always remained intertwined. The co-ordinating crescent at the centre signifies peace, and the Star a steady source of light. The motto means 'Pray and Work'.
