Out of 128 responses, 76 respondents belong to female students, and the rest of them are male students 52. 59.38% of female students

showed more interest towards digital library utilization compared to male students 40.62% (Table 1).




Figure 1: No. of respondents gender-wise.




Figure 2: Frequency of digital library visits by students.

The data was collected from 128 (52 males and 76 females). Fig. 1 reflects that out of 128 responses of students 25.78 % of female students prefer to visit the digital library daily, whereas only 21.09 % of male students prefer it.

Secondly, 9.4 % of female students prefer to visit the digital library twice a week but 6.25% of male students prefer it. The least visited percentage in the digital library is male (1.6%), whereas female (3.12%) prefers it (Fig. 2).




Figure 3: Purpose of visiting the digital library by students.

Fig. 3 clearly shows that most of the students utilize the digital library for information gathering or to collect information related to their current subjects from various sources available in the digital library 42%. Secondly, to access the organizational subscribed e-packages (e-books, e-journals etc.) in the library 26%.

Delnet and NDLI-related information was also accessed through the digital library at 10% and 13%. Other related works like checking their email, browsing to know the important dates, registration etc., 9%. It clearly shows the importance of the digital library part of library (Table 2).





Figure 4: Digital library resources utilized by the student.




Figure 6: Workflow of the digital library.

The workflow of the digital library is given in Fig. 6.
