



ANNUAL REPORT: FAROOK COLLEGE 1990-91

I am happy to present a report of the college for the academic year 1990-91.

The college offers courses in Pre-degree (four groups), Degree (Economics, English, Arabic & Islamic History, Malayalam, Sociology, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, commerce) and Post-graduate Degree (English, Arabic, Islamic History, Economics, Commerce, Mathematics, Zoology, Chemistry, Physics, Statistics) The department of English and that of Zoology & wildlife Biology are approved research centres.

The strength of students this year was 2471 (1149 for Pre-degree 1071 for Degree, and 251 for P.G). The figures include 15 students from Sudan and one from Jordan.

Library

The College Library at present has a collection of 54,548 volumes. 713 bo
were procured this year. The No of periodicals subscribed for is 125, of wh
72 are bound and preserved. The bound periodical section has a collection
1692. There is a separate collection of audio-visual aids including films, filmst
slides audio and video cassettes, gramophone records etc.

This year the Library utilized more than Rupees one lakh for the purch
of books, periodicals and audio-visual aids.

Publicity programmes like exhibitions, distribution of booklets etc. were or
nized for the effective use of the Library. Arrangements are being made
computerise some of the sections of the college Library.

Scholarships etc : A total of 1582 students were granted various scholarsh
concessions and other financial assistance. They include 8 National Loan Sch
ships, 5 National Merit Scholarships, and 16 University Merit Scholarships.

Physical Education : The year's activities started with the University Coaching Camp in football.

Our football team won the Calicut University 'B' Zone championship for the seventh year in succession. Our kho-kho team secured the third place in University championship. Our ball-badminton team were runners-up in 'B' Zone. The College table tennis team come up second (individual) in the inter-zone tournament. Our teams also participated in basket ball, volley-ball, lawn tennis and shuttle badminton tournaments.

The College cricket team secured Third place in the District League Championship.

Biju Anad, Abdul Gafoor and Rajeev B.K. were selected to the University Football team. Jamshad got selection in the University table tennis team, Rajan and Ravi in University kho-kho team, and Rajee Mohan. in University cricket team. Shajahan secured II place in University Athletic Meet.

Hyder Khan, MD, convener, Central Panel, IDB (India) on 16. 9. 90. The commencement of the new Hostel has relieved the accommodation problem of the women students in the campus to a very great extent and also promoted women's education as a whole.

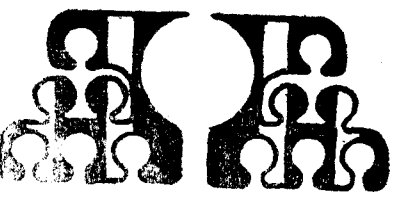
