

ANNUAL REPORT: FAROOK COLLEGE 1990-91

I am happy to present a report of the college for the academic year 1990-91.

The college offers courses in Pre-degree (four groups), Degree (Economics, English, Arabic & Islamic History, Malayalam, Sociology, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, commerce) and Post-graduat Degree (English, Arabic, Islamic History, Economics, Commerce, Mathematics, Zoology, Chemistry, Physics, Statistics) The department of Engish and that of Zoology & wildlife Biology are approved research centres.

The strength of students this year was 2471 (1149 for Pre-degree 1071 for Degree, and 251 for PG). The figures include 15 students from sudan and one from Jordan.
