



## FAROOK COLLEGE

### FORTY SIXTH ANNUAL REPORT PRESENTED BY PRINCIPAL, PROF. V.V. KUNHABDULLA.

It is a matter of great pleasure for me to present the 46th Annual Report of Farook College.

The College offers instruction in two-year Pre-degree (four groups, seven batches), three-year degree (11 subjects) and two-year Post-graduate (10 subjects) courses. This year we have embarked on professional courses with the addition of one-year Library & Information Science Course. English and Zoology are ap-

proved research centres.

The strength of students this year is 2382.

A total of 1016 students are enjoying scholarships and concessions as follows. National Merit (7), University Merit (15), Scholarship under K.P.C. report (117), Govt. of India Scholarship to SC/ST (329), Scholarship to Physically Handicapped (32), for Blind (9), Cultural scholarship (12), Sports (2), District Welfare Scholar-

ship (3), State Merit (18), Labour Welfare (8), Muslim & Nadar Girls (65), Kelappan Memorial (2), Temple Entry (3) Others (31), OBC Concessions (358), Concession & stipend to OEC (5).

### LIBRARY:

The college library has a collection of 56,000 volumes, 461 being this year's addition. We subscribe for 112 periodicals, out of which 53 are bound and preserved. The bound periodicals section as nearly 1929 volumes. There is a separate collection of Audio-Visual Aids including films, film strips, audio and video cassettes, gramophone records, slides etc. There is also computer-based Information Storage and Retrieval System. This year the Library utilized more than Rs. 81,347/-.

### College Union:

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The performance of our chess and foot-ball team this year was creditable. The chess team under captain Shafeeq. O.P. captured the University championship. Shafeeq. O.P. Captured the Individual Championship also. Our foot-ball team won the District B Division championship and was promoted to A Division.

We fielded almost all the teams in the University & District Level tournaments during this year. Our cricket team and ball badminton team became the runners up in the Calicut University B Zone tournament. Our Kho-kho team (Men) secured II place in the District League championship.

In University Athletics at Kannur, Sujith Kumar Madhavan, I B.Sc. broke the existing record in shot put (Boys Section). He also won the first place in the shot put (under 20) in the state level. Shohrab, II PDC represented the University Cricket team as well as the Kerala State team, Shafeeq. O.P. represented the university Chess team.

### **N.C. C (Army):**

There are 79 cadets on the rolls. 2 cadets passed C certificate exam. and 9 cadets passed B certificate examination. Capt. R.V. Ibrahim and 3 cadets attended the National Integration camp at Velur, Salem in Jan. 1994. Apart from the usual parades, weapon training was also imparted to cadets. Firing was conducted at Melmuri range, Malappuram.

### **N.C.C. (Navy)**

The strength of NCC (Navy) is 50. Twentyfive cadets participated in various annual training camps. One cadet viz. Mohamed Ashraf and the Officer S/Lt. Abdur Rasheed participated in the All India Sea Training camp held at Bombay in January 1994. Four cadets participated in the Nau Sainik camp held at Visakapatnam. All cadets and the officer participated in "clean Calicut campaign" in connection with the NCC Day. Fifteen cadets participated in cycle expedition along with Nehru Yuvak Kendra volunteers.

### **EXTENSION ACTIVITIES**

#### **N.S.S.:**

On August 20, 1993, the NSS observed Sad Bhavana Day. The vattakundu Project of our NSS units was telecast by Door Darsan on 22 Aug. 93. Mr. Hafis Ul Azab M.A. II B.Sc. Chem. participated in a one-day Inter-University camp conducted at Trivandrum. On 22nd Sept. blood grouping camp was organized. 164 students donated blood for emergency cases of patients. Two-day orientation camp for fresh volunteers was inaugurated by Prof. K.A. Jaleel, Former Vice-Chancellor, on 30th Sept. 1993. Prabhat. K.P. won the Inter Collegiate Postur competition. Santhi. K.P. and Ahamed Siraj participated in Technical Workshop at R.E.C. Calicut. 35 NSS volunteers and two programme officers participated in the State Silver Jubilee of NSS at Trichur. One-day Inter-Collegiate girls symposium on "Women in Advertisement" was held on 27th Nov. 1993. A two-day educational survey

was conducted at M.M. High School area. 35 volunteers and two programme officers participated in the OISCA International camp at the University campus. One volunteer and one programme officer attended N.I. camp at Jaipur.

### **PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION:**

During the year, PTA constructed an extension block to the college library costing about rupees 3 lakhs. This was inaugurated by the District Collector, Kozhikode. Construction of a Waiting Room for ladies has started. This may cost about Rs. 1 lakh.

To solve the transport problem, a sub committee of the P.T.A. was formed and this committee had met the Kozhikode and Malappuram District Collectors and R.T.Os. and much has been done in this line.

PTA gave cash prizes to students securing highest marks in each group in the Half Yearly Exam. conducted by the college. This is to encourage the students in their studies. P.T.A. also gave prizes to the students who secured ranks in the Calicut University Exams. of April/May 1993. P.T.A. also gave financial assistance to the college union and also to the poor boys.

### **PRE-EXAMINATION COACHING CENTRE FOR MINORITIES**

During January-March, short courses were held for Calicut University Asst. Test, MBA orientation classes, Remedial classes in the college and at Calicut, and Remedial classes for I Degree classes. JRF/Lecturership Intensive Coaching was given to 3 students in June. Two passed the test.

Entrance coaching classes have a strength of 45 for Medicine (15 selected) and 33 for Engineering (13 selected).

Entrance-oriented classes for I PDC commenced in Aug. with strengths of 83 for Medicine, and 42 for Engineering.

JRF/Lecturership (Humanities) classes started in October. There were 27 trainees in this course.

Coaching was given in October to applicants for BSRB Test. Remedial classes are being held in M.M. High School, Calicut from October 1993 onwards.

### **ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMME**

Under the Adult Education Programme, we are managing one Jansikshan Nilayam at Karuvanthiruthy, Feroke and one Population Education Club besides one Continuing Education Centre. National Integration Seminar held at Karuvanthiruthy, Feroke and a process on was arranged. A special conference for Educational Improvement was held by the JSN and awarded prizes to rank holders of SSLC and Pre-degree. Literacy competitions were held at extension centres and at Farook College. Youth meets were arranged at Aroor, Feroke and Thiruthiyad. Two-days camp conducted for women at Farook Training College. Extension Lectures on Population Education and Health Education were also held by experts. Programme officers and Prerak of JSN attended the Residential Training Camp from 22nd to 24th Jan. at I.B. Peruvannamuzhi. Both P.O. and Prerak attended the one-day camp at the University of Calicut.

### **Old Students Association**

The Association is providing free lunch to eight selected poor students of the college.

A career Guidance and Placement Bureau has been set up and it will start functioning shortly. The office of the Association has started functioning in the old students' home building.

### **Students Advisory Scheme.**

The students are being given guidance from their teachers through the Advisory Scheme. The guardians of the irregular students are also being contacted by their Advisers, regarding their bad performance and irregular attendance in classes. Special arrangements are made to give coaching to the weaker students through the Advisory Scheme.

### **Conclusion**

On the whole this was a year that showed fairly satisfactory performance both in curricular and co-curricular areas. However, there has to be greater stress on excellence. Our students should be able to rise above mediocrity in academic sports and Cultural spheres. Farook College has a tradition of producing outstanding personalities, and we have to strive to keep up the tradition.

On 19th Nov 1993 Union hosted a Reception function to the winners of inter University chess championships. At the same function Switzerland grand masters offered felicitation to the winners.

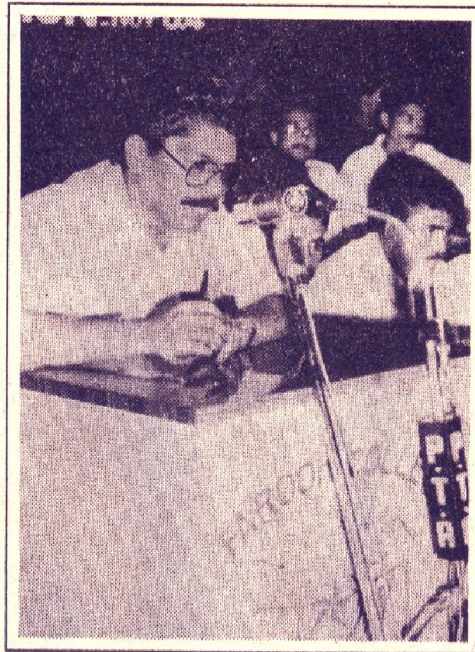
