On 19th January, the researchers presented papers on the wide issues regarding the history of dam, its present status, the social implications, the agitation and also the possible solutions. To strengthen personal effectiveness and to build positive self image, Mr. Mohammed Ikan, the International trainer trained 200 students from 18 colleges of different universities in the workshop- Lakshya 2012 organized by the department on 11th February, 2012. As part of the academic exercise, the Department conducted a talk and interaction with Dr. Joni C. Joseph, the Supervising Teacher of Doctoral Research in Sociology, University of Kannur .

An effective Power Point presentation on the topic Inventing The Hidden Facts opened new venues for students on the purpose and scope of research. The Department arranged a venue for discussion of question of energy crisis in the context of Koodankulam. The eminent environmentalist and activist, Mr. C.R. PROF. K.A.JALEEL (1922-2012)

The Architect of Farook College



Prof. K.A. Jaleel was born as the son of late B. Kunhali and Naseema (both belonging to North Paravur) on September 22, 1922. He was graduated from the University College, Trivandrum in 1945 and obtained post-graduate degree from Travancore University in 1946.

Prof. Jaleel started his career as a Lecturer in English, at Islamiah College, Vaniyambadi. He served Farook College as Lecturer & Professor from 1948 to 1957 and as Principal for more than two decades from 1957 to 1979. During his long tenure as Principal he was chiefly respon-

sible for planning and executing important developmental schemes on the campus and for eventually converting it to a well-equipped reputed temple of learning. Prof. Jaleel is ipso facto the architect of Farook College. Following this, he served as Vice Chancellor, University of Calicut, from 1979 to 1983.

Prof. Jaleel was an enthusiastic educationist who made outstanding contributions to the society and to the nation, performing many important roles in his long career.

- Member, Academic Councils of the Universities: Madras University (1948-51) and University of Calicut (1968-78).
- Founder Chairman of Social Advancement Foundation of India (SAFI)
- Chairman of Kerala Wakf Board during (1998-2003).

Prof. Jaleel has several publications to his credit in English and Malayalam. Humor in Ancient Greek Literature, Education in the Ancient World, Vidyabyasa Nirikshanangal, New Horizons, Thirinchi Nokkumbol, Lipikalum Manava Samskaravum are some of them. He was honoured with many awards and distinctions. He received IC Chacko Award instituted by the Kerala Sahithya Academy (1991), Sha Saheb Award (1992), Senior Citizen Excellence Award (1994), Ramashramam Award (1997) Rotary Award for Excellence in Education (1997) and Gem Serve Award for outstanding Service to society, Shaikh Zahid Award are some of the major awards he received. After rendering meritorious service to the academic and social fields, Prof. Jaleel expired on 12th September, 2012. The academic community has benefitted immensely from his great service and will always remember him with respect.
